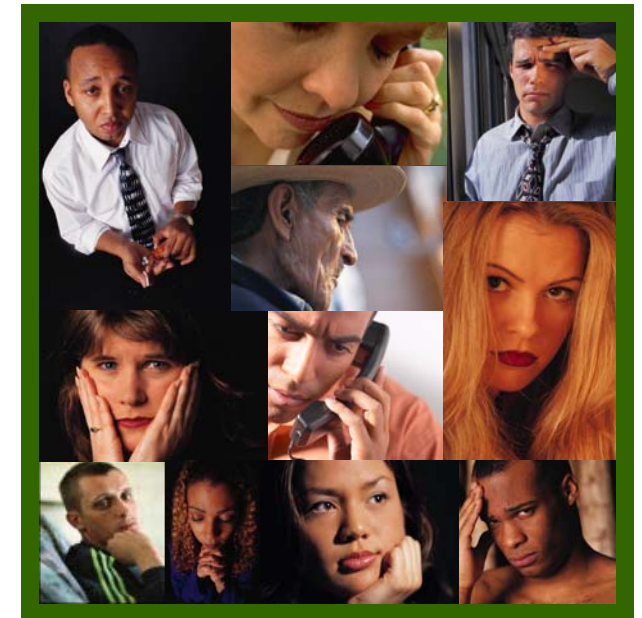

# Outpatient Services

## An Overview...

The Adult Services Outpatient Program is an integral part of the continuum of care offered by DISC Village, Inc. Specializing in the treatment of chemical dependence and addiction, we offer comprehensive outpatient and case management services to concerned individuals and families.

## Admissions...

Admission is voluntary for adults seeking treatment for chemical dependence or other related issues. During the initial consultation session, an assessment of the individual's and families needs and suitability for outpatient treatment is determined.

The consultation is ***confidential*** and without obligation. Should an individual be considered inappropriate for the outpatient component, a referral to another program or service will be provided.

## Services...

Outpatient services are provided by trained professionals experienced in assessment, diagnosis, and treatment of chemically dependent individuals and their families. We are committed to prevention, intervention, and quality treatment directed toward long-term recovery.

## Individual Counseling:

Intensive one-on-one counseling based on a program of complete abstinence. Family members are encouraged to participate with the individual in counseling. Significant others may also attend individual counseling with an adult outpatient counselor.

## Group Counseling:

Specialty groups are offered for adults and their families including:

- Basic Group Counseling
- Intensive Group Counseling
- Relapse Prevention

## Case Management:

Case management is a significant part of all treatment offered. Referrals may be made to other community agencies to meet legal, medical, educational, spiritual, vocational or other service needs.

## Accreditation and Licensure...

All service components are fully licensed and accredited.

- Licensed by the State of Florida
- Accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF)

## Quality Assurance...

Continual internal and external review of all services to insure the highest standard of services.

## Fees for Services...

DISC Village, Inc. is a private, non-profit agency. Counseling fees are based on a sliding scale. Urinalysis testing is a flat rate of \$20 per test. Assistance is available for filing insurance claims.

## Confidentiality...

It is imperative that confidentiality be observed for therapeutic progress to occur. Strict adherence to all Federal as well as Florida Statutes is maintained.
