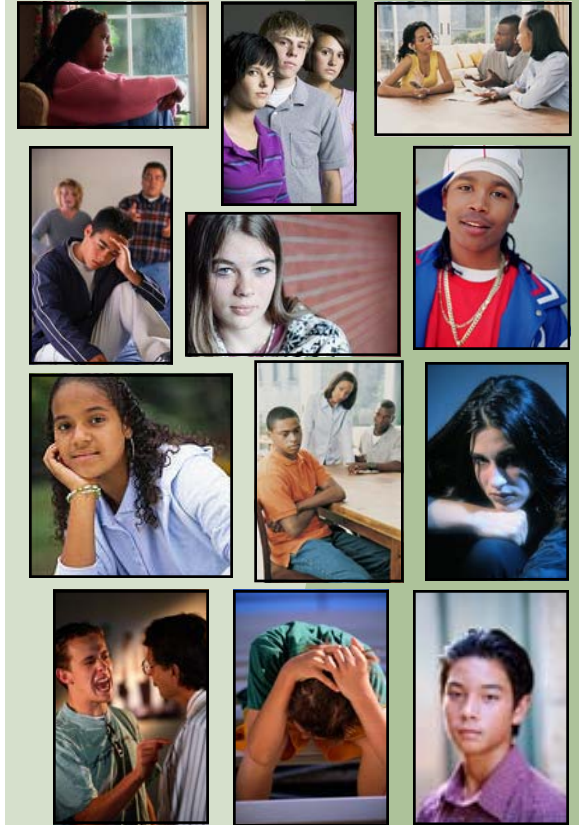

What is the Juvenile Outpatient Program?

The Juvenile Outpatient Program is an integral part of the continuum of care offered by DISC Village, Inc. Specializing in the treatment of chemical use and abuse, we offer comprehensive outpatient and case management services to concerned individuals and their families.

How can I access services?

Admission can be voluntary or court-ordered for adolescents and teenagers seeking treatment for chemical dependence or related issues. The initial consultation includes an assessment of the individual's and family's needs and suitability for outpatient treatment. Should an individual be considered inappropriate for the outpatient component, a referral to a more suitable program or service will be provided to them.

Is it confidential?

It is imperative that confidentiality be observed for therapeutic progress to occur. Strict adherence to all Federal and Florida Statutes is maintained.

Who provides the program's services?

Outpatient services are provided by trained professionals experienced in assessment, diagnosis, and treatment of chemically dependent individuals and their families. We are committed to prevention, intervention, and quality treatment directed toward long term recovery.
