

# An Overview

The purpose of the Selected Family Interventions (SFI) program is to increase children's stability and safety in their own homes while the family increases the ability to care for one another. The major goal is to ensure children's safety and well-being. Services are provided in an effort to prevent the occurrence or recurrence of abuse, neglect, or abandonment.

The Selected Family Interventions team provides science-based, in-home counseling services for families who are at risk of having the child removed due to abuse or neglect. The focus of the services is to support the child's continued placement in the home and to stabilize the family so future removals or threat of removals will not be necessary.

# Eligibility & Referrals

The Selected Family Interventions (SFI) program serves families in Franklin, Gadsden, Jefferson, Leon, Liberty, and Wakulla counties.

The SFI program works in cooperation with the Department of Children and Families and Big Bend Community Based Care. Child Protective Investigators (CPI) who respond to reports of child abuse and/or neglect may request services for contributing risk factors to the investigation.

Referrals for the program come from the CPI and/or Dependency Case Manager (when applicable). Length of services will vary but on the average will run from 10 to 12 weeks depending on the needs of the family. The program and the model are designed to help families in need of services and where transportation may be a problem. It is also targeted at providing services to families in order to prevent children from being removed from the home.

The Selected Family Interventions (SFI) program model was created to provide a systemic framework for providing interventions to children, adolescents and families who are experiencing challenges with:

- Substance Use
- Anger Management
- Parenting
- Mental Health
- Abuse and/or Neglect

All services are provided in home. SFI is designed with the recognition that a “one-size-fits-all” model is not the most effective or efficient way to provide interventions to families with varied needs and strengths as well as low to high levels of risk. Alternatively, SFI is a model that includes core (family) sessions that families can benefit from plus a vast assortment of manualized research based interventions that can be differentially selected and flexibly packaged to meet the unique needs of families.

# Confidentiality

It is imperative that confidentiality be observed for therapeutic progress to occur. Strict adherence to all Federal as well as Florida Statutes is maintained.
