

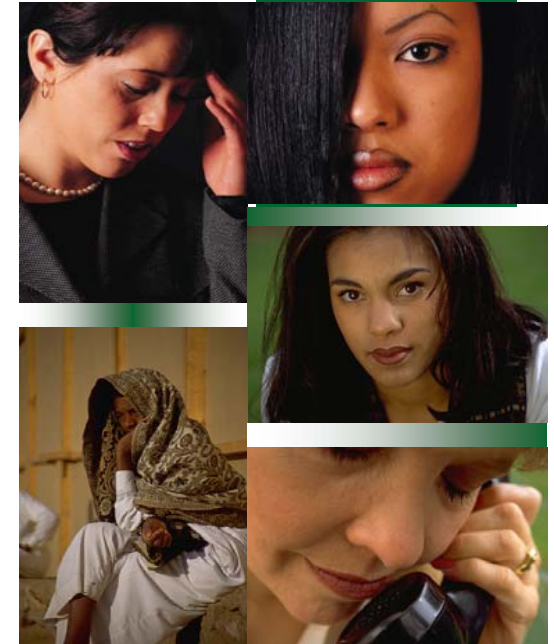
An Overview

Sisters in Sobriety (SIS) is a moderate to long-term residential treatment program that provides a comprehensive array of services to address the special needs of women alcoholics and addicts. We believe that chemical dependency is a primary disease that affects the physical, emotional, and spiritual health of those it touches. Our goal is to empower women and their families with the hope that a chemical free life is attainable, the belief in one's ability to live chemical free, and the strength to work for it. Pregnancy and post-partum women receive specialized care and treatment planning.

Admissions

Admission is voluntary for adult women who are age eighteen (18) and older with a primary diagnosis of chemical dependency. Clients who are court ordered to the program must be willing to fully participate in all aspects of the program.

Services

SIS is a therapeutic community that provides clinical assessment, treatment planning, case management, individual counseling, group therapy, life skills classes, discharge planning and relapse prevention. Support services include vocational assessment, training and placement, and Adult Education/GED classes. Recreation is part of the daily schedule. Medical and nursing services are available 24 hours a day. Family participation is encouraged through providing weekly visitation, Family Group, and a system of passes for home visits. Pre-natal care, post-partum care, two furnished nurseries, nutritional screening and counseling, and case management and referrals are available for pregnancy and post-partum mothers.

Continuing Care Services

Residential treatment provides the “tools” necessary to maintain sobriety after discharge. The “Continuing Care” phase of treatment helps clients make the transition back to living in the community and learning to use the “tools” in day to day living. This phase includes weekly group counseling, random urinalysis, case management, attendance at support group meetings and referrals for outpatient counseling, if needed. Completion of this phase of treatment is necessary for successful completion of SIS.

Fees for Service

DISC Village, Inc. is a private, non-profit agency. Fees are based on a sliding scale. Assistance is available for filing insurance claims.

Licensure & Accreditation

Sisters in Sobriety is fully licensed by the State of Florida and is accredited through CARF.

Confidentiality

It is imperative that confidentiality be observed for the therapeutic process to occur. Strict adherence to all Federal as well as Florida Statutes is maintained.
